RECIPE Chicken Pie

- 2 sheets ready rolled puff pastry
- 440g can condensed cream of chicken soup
- 1 cup cooked chicken, skinless & cubed
- 500g mixed veggies, thawed



Method

Preheat oven to 180C. Line a greased pie dish with first sheet of pastry. Combine remaining ingredients in a bowl, season with salt and pepper and pour into pastry. Cover with remaining sheet, seal edges well. Cut a few slits in the pie lid and bake for 30 minutes, or until lid is golden brown.
